Expert Speakers



Prof. (Dr.) Sudhir Kumar Satpathy is currently serving as Director of School of Public Health, KIIT Deemed to be University. He is a medical doctor, public health specialist and epidemiologist and has a distinguished professional career of 40 years mainly serving developing countries like India and Nigeria. He has worked with Govt. of India, NGOs (PHFI), International agencies and private sector in a lead role. His major contribution is in capacity building of public health professionals, formulation of Indian Public Standards for Primary and Secondary level health facilities, mentoring public health programs, establishing quality assurance mechanism in public health facilities, infectious diseases, NCDs and health system strengthning.



Dr. Kiranjeet Kaur joined Chitkara University, Punjab in 2016 as Assistant Professor at Chitkara School of Health Sciences. Since January 2020, she has been appointed as the coordinator of ERASMUS plus funded project entitled 'Risk Management and Prevention of Antibiotics Resistance'. Her areas of expertise include antibiotic resistance, disinfectants, contraceptives, lung cancer and premature hair graying. She has participated in various national and international workshops and has peer reviewed publications to her credit. She is a life member of Association of Microbiologists of India (AMI).



Dr. Prakash Narayanan Vasudevan Potty is currently working as Associate Professor at Prasanna School of Public Health, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal. He is actively involved in teaching and research. His area of research includes Communicable and non-communicable diseases, Occupational health, Reproductive health, Nutrition, Mental health, Digital health, Zoonoses, One Health, Drug resistance. He has conducted more than 25 national level research studies in HIV, Reproductive Health, Family Planning, Education and Child Labour. He has guided various students at both doctorate and master's level.



Prof. (Dr.) B Sunil working as Professor at Department of Veterinary Public Health and Head, Centre of Excellence in Meat Science & Technology, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Thrissur, Kerela. He has 26 years of experience in teaching, research and extention activities in the area of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Public Health. Prof.Sunil has been involved in training of Veterinarians, Medical professionals, Food Safety Officers, Industry personnel, Entrepreneurs in areas of food safety, Hazard and risk analysis and Implementation of HACCP, GMP and One Health.



Prof. (Dr.) Helmut Brand is Jean Monnet Professor of European Public Health and head of the Department of International Health at Maastricht University, The Netherlands. After working in several Health Authorities and Ministries of Health he was director of the Public Health Institute of North-Rhine Westphalia, Germany. For ten years he consulted the European Agency for Reconstruction regarding the Balkan countries. He is past-president of the Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region (ASPHER) and past-president of the European Health Forum Gastein (EHFG). As policy advisor he served on the European Advisory Committee on Health Research (EACHR) of WHO Europe and on the Expert Panel on "Investing in Health" (EXPH) for the European Commission. At Manipal Academy of Higher Education, India he acts as Founding Director of the Prasanna School of Public Health.



Mr. N.M.Mohan is having 30 years experience in Rural and Urban development. He has been working with Rural Institute for People Enlightenment (RIPE), NGO Since 1990 as Secretary & Chief Executive Officer. He was incharge of around 42 projects and the activities during this period. He also worked as Individual Monitor in National Minorities Finance Development Corporation (NMFDC), Ministry of Minorities, Govt. of India, during period from 2005 to 2012.
